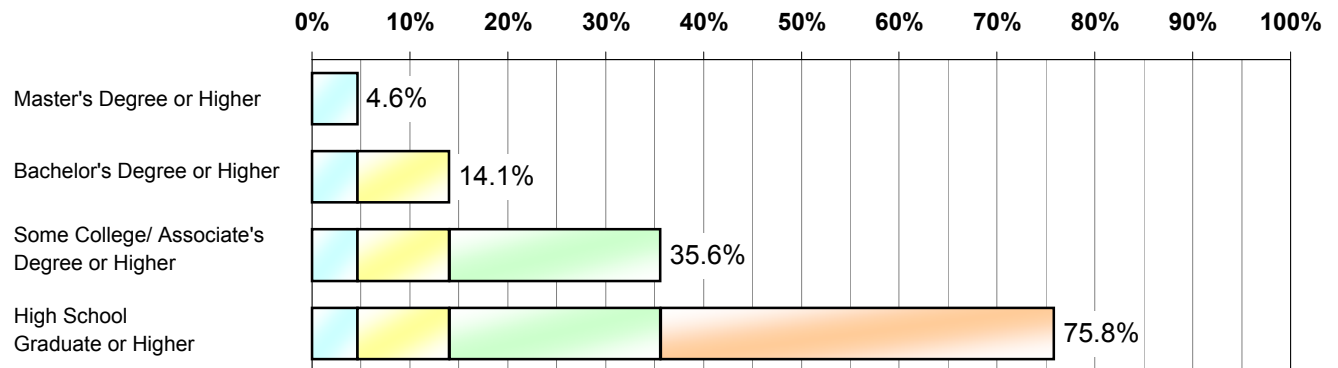

| Sensory<br>blindness, deafness, severe vision/hearing impairment   | 7,076        | 3.8%  |
| Physical<br>condition substantially limiting one or more basic physical activities,<br>such as walking, climbing stairs, reaching, lifting or carrying | 18,887       | 10.2% |
| Mental<br>difficulty in learning, remembering or concentrating   | 10,323       | 5.6%  |
| Self-care<br>difficulty in dressing, bathing, or getting around inside the home  | 6,211        | 3.4%  |
| Going Outside the Home (Age 16+)<br>difficulty in going outside the home alone to shop or visit the doctor   | 15,580       | 8.5%  |
| Employment (Age 16-64)<br>difficulty in working at a job or business   | 17,457       | 9.5%  |
